We all know how we're supposed to act toward others, so the focus will be on those unusual or difficult situations. How have you handled any of the following: people who have victimized you; people who ask you for charity on the street; people who have hurt one of your loved ones; or you could mention any ethical dilemma you have faced where it was not at all clear how you should treat someone else.
